A Message from the Pastor...

Winter in Ohio can be pretty drab (although as I write this, the sun is shining, the temperature is near 50 degrees, we still have had no snow to shovel, and Fr. Ritter is on the golf course—I hope this mention doesn't break the charm!). But there is nothing drab about the faith growth and spiritual enrichment opportunities here at St. Joe's this winter.

There are several Bible study groups back in action; there will be a discussion group on Matthew Kelly's book *Rediscover Catholicism*; there will also be a program (daytime and evening) on Robert Barron's excellent *Catholicism* series, seen by many on PBS last year. And of course, Matthew Kelly himself will be in Findlay on March 10 for *Passion & Purpose Live*, co-sponsored by our parish. Check Joanne Denyer's column or call her for more information on any of these wonderful opportunities.

But this week I would like to highlight another spiritual growth opportunity, which has been enriching the lives of St. Joseph parishioners for decades, i.e. Christ Renews His Parish, commonly referred to as "Chirp," although I have never figured out why, as the "r" precedes the "h" (CRHP).

Whatever name we give it, CRHP has enriched the lives of more than 2000 parishioners since 1985. Next month we will host the 43rd retreat for both women (Feb. 11/12) and men (Feb. 25/26).

As a pastor, one of the ways I have always evaluated parish programs and events is by using Jesus' words from the Sermon on the Mount: "by their fruits shall you know them." (Matt. 7:16) The fruits of Christ Renews His Parish have been extraordinary, both in individual lives and in the lives of the parish.

I have witnessed lives changed, relationships cultivated and an overwhelming attachment to the Lord strengthened in many, many people. Friendships begun at this weekend have indeed lasted a lifetime. And the parish thrives as well as a result of CRHP, not only by the deepened faith life of many individual retreatants, but also because many of these individuals then choose to get involved in other dimensions of parish life and ministry, enriching us all.

Perhaps this is the first time you have heard of CRHP. If so, I encourage you to consider making this retreat. More likely, you have heard this announcement many times. If so, perhaps this is the year to "take the plunge." I guarantee that you will not regret that decision!

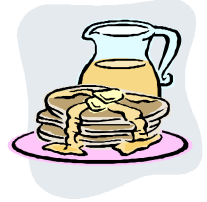
