## Mary, the Holy Mother of God

January 1, 2012



### A Message from the Pastor...

Happy New Year! On this first Sunday/Holyday of the year we honor Mary, the Mother of God, and following the directive of each pope in the last 50 years, we also begin the year praying for peace in our troubled and violent world. Pope John Paul II once said, "Peace is not just the absence of war. Like a cathedral, peace must be constructed patiently and with unshakable faith." The foundation of that "cathedral of peace" must be the peace that rests in our hearts, our families and our own local community. What can each of us do to be a peacemaker in our own part of the world?

Because of publishing deadlines, I write this several days *before* Christmas, but I can already thank you for your generous contributions in the Christmas collection, as many pre-Christmas envelopes have insured that we will indeed have a merry Christmas. Did you know that the origin of the word "merry" does not mean "happy" or "joyful," but *blessed*? We are truly blessed in this great parish of St. Joseph, most of all by the faith and generosity of so many of you.

I am so grateful to all who made our Christmas liturgies so inspiring: musicians, choirs, liturgical ministers and ushers. Special thanks also to all who were involved in decorating our church so beautifully, including Fr. Ritter who is responsible for the "angels on high." And your generosity to people in need during this season was astounding. Through our Adopt a Family program, we made Christmas a brighter time for almost 200 families this year! Thanks to all who contributed or coordinated that monumental effort.

On a personal note, thank you for the many, many cards, kind wishes and gifts that came my way during this season. Way too many sweets! According to all the health care charts, I need to lose 25 pounds, so that regimen begins tomorrow!

Among the many pastoral tasks in my life, one which I particularly enjoy is preparing couples for marriage, which I do 15-20 times per year. I meet with each couple in four or five one-hour sessions, during which we discuss a variety of things. One session (or sometimes two) is spent discussing the **FOCCUS** instrument (Facilitating Open Couple Communication, Understanding & Study). This tool consists of 168 one-line statements, to which bride and groom mark "agree" or "disagree." The statements fall into ten different categories (e.g. Communication, Finance, Faith and Values, Sexuality, Covenant...). We then spend time discussing issues where bride and groom disagree. Universally, couples seem to find this fun and helpful. It is *not* a compatibility test.

There is also an instrument called **REFOCCUS** (Relationship Enrichment Facilitating Open Couple Communication, Understanding & Study), which is designed to help married couples understand, discuss and enrich their marriage. REFOCCUS is not as extensive as the original FOCCUS, and the couple goes through the process themselves, without a facilitator (me!) interpreting the results. It focuses on five areas: (1) Marriage as a Process, (2) Intimacy, (3) Compatibility, (4) Communication, and (5) Commitment. I have never used this tool, and I am looking for a "guinea pig" couple or two to try it and see if it might be something worthwhile to offer on a wider scale in the parish. If you might be interested, please contact me.
