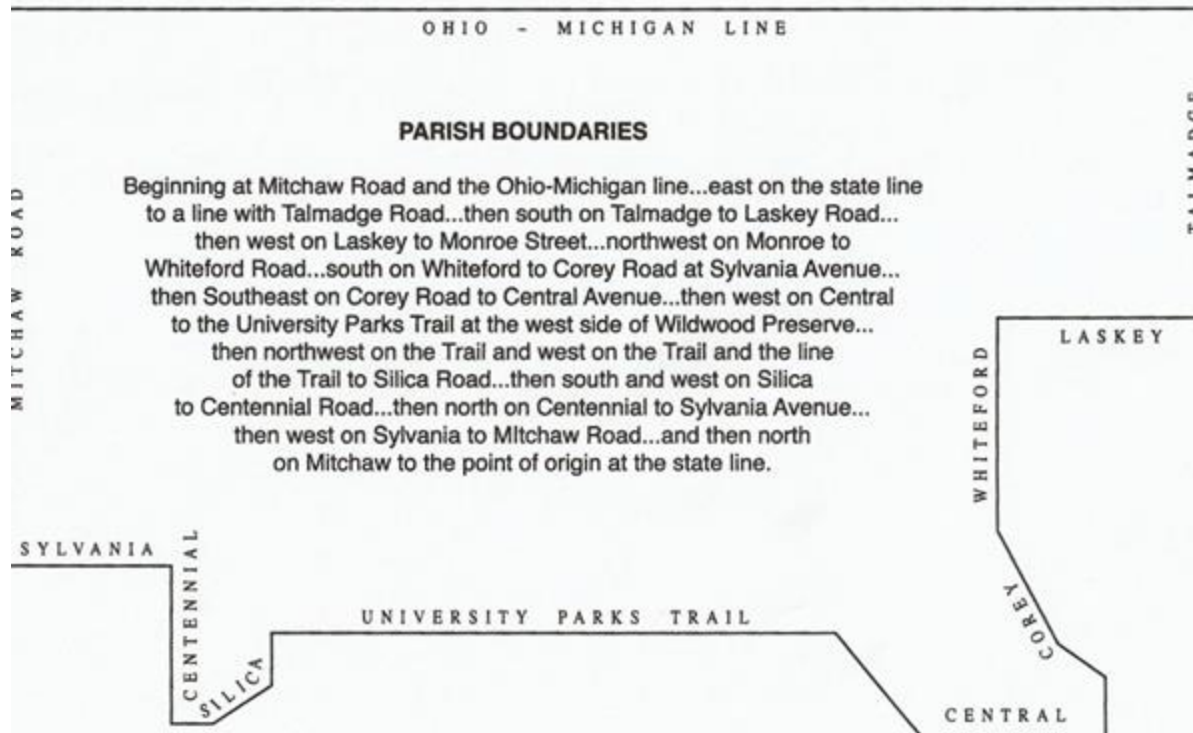
The Saint Joseph Parish council has been active for over 50 years. The financial resources for the conference are provided by generous donations from our parishioners to help their neighbors.
